ALL Endorsement applicants have to sign a *Code of Ethics & Endorsement Agreement*, provide *Documentation of Competencies*, and have a current Professional Membership with COAIMH to complete their application.

Endorsement Renewal: All Endorsees have to complete a minimum of 15 clock hours/year of relationship-based education and training, pertaining to the promotion of social-emotional development and/or the practice of infant mental health (e.g. regional training, related course work at colleges or universities, infant mental health conference attendance) and maintain a current COAIMH membership. Documentation of training hours are submitted with membership renewal.
