

The Application for the 2021/2022 Reflective Supervision/Consultation Learning Collaborative is OPEN!

CoAIMH will accept 35 participants in total into the cohort with 10 slots being made available to primary Spanish Speaking members.

Below is information that will be helpful to your understanding of the RSCLC.

- This RS/C Learning Collaborative was created to increase local and regional access to quality RS/C by establishing a 14-month Full Scholarship RS/C Learning Collaborative for 30-35 emerging/"junior" RS/C providers.
- Applicants must indicate their intent to complete the training and 14-month learning collaborative support to gain The Endorsement for Culturally Sensitive, Relationship-Focused Practice Promoting Infant and Early Childhood Mental Health (IECMH-E®).
- A cohort of applicants indicating intent to proceed to *Endorsement*® will be selected and will receive an introduction to, and individualized application support for, The Endorsement for Culturally Sensitive, Relationship-Focused Practice Promoting Infant Early Childhood Mental Health (IECMH-E®), including payment of the “Endorsement” application registration and submission fees.
- You will have the opportunity to build a RSC learning community in a cohort of 5, receiving RSC online from a Master RSC provider. This includes (4) hours of Group Reflective Supervision monthly, plus additional one on one support, which will fulfill the Endorsement® requirements of 50 hours within a 1-2 year period.
- The trainings will be held during the weeks of April 23rd, 2021 and October 4th, 2021. *April will be online, October TBD.
- Bachelor’s, Master’s degree or advanced degree in process.
- Completed applications must be submitted to info@coaimh.org by close of business on **March 5th**.
